The Joyful Mysteries

[Traditionally prayed on Mondays, Saturdays, & during the season of Advent on Sundays]

1st Joyful Mystery – The Annunciation

Fruit of the mystery: Humility



† Grant us, Mary, by the graces of this mystery, a listening heart that responds to the call of the Lord with a loving yes joined to yours.

Scripture: "In the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David, and the virgin's name was Mary." Luke 1:26-27

Mary: "My little Carmelite, so many sins are committed in this country. Help me. Let us save the country. I place a beam of light in your hands; it is the Flame of Love of my heart. Add your love to this Flame and pass it on to others, my little one." (April 13, 1962)

Jesus: "Suffer with love and listen to My voice with greater love. To hear My voice, you must be very silent. Only souls plunged into My love can hear My delicate and silent voice. Keep your desire for Me alive and be a living host for love. Only the constant acceptance of sacrifices keeps the fire of love burning." (April 17, 1962)

2nd Joyful Mystery – The Visitation

Fruit of the mystery: Love of Neighbor



† Open our hearts, Mary, to give joyfully and without counting and in a gratuitousness of love, as you did at the Visitation.

Scripture: "When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the holy Spirit, cried out in a loud voice and said, 'Most blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb.'" Luke 1:39-42

Mary: "I would like to place in your hands a new instrument, which I want you to accept and appreciate the importance of, because my heart looks upon my country with great affliction." (Good Friday, April 13, 1962)

Jesus: "If you ask for souls, can I refuse your petitions? No. Otherwise, I would be acting against My work of Salvation. I always hear your persevering prayer." (June 24, 1963)

3rd Joyful Mystery – Nativity of Jesus

Fruit of the mystery: Poverty



† Mary, tenderness of the poor, make us discover the true wealth of the Kingdom, you who lived them at the birth of Jesus.

Scripture: "And Joseph too went up from Galilee from the town of Nazareth to Judea, to the city of David that is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and family

of David, to be enrolled with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child. While they were there, the time came for her to have her child, and she gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped him in swaddling clothes and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn." Luke 2:1-7

Jesus: "Let only the Holy Spirit of Love fill your heart. Love Me as an infant wrapped up in his white swaddling clothes. Seek Me like My Mother once sought Me among the crowd with an anxious heart. And wherever you are, rejoice because of Me!" (April 20, 1962)

Mary: "Now we set out, my little Carmelite, together with Saint Joseph. You must walk with us along Bethlehem's dark roads covered with mist. You have to seek a refuge for my Flame of Love, which is Jesus Christ himself. Do you want to come with us? Because it is now that we are leaving to carry on my Flame of Love. You will receive strength and grace from us." (August 31, 1962)

4th Joyful Mystery – Presentation of Jesus in the Temple

Fruit of the mystery: Purity of Heart and Body



† Grant us, Mary, that we may recognize the Light of God in our lives, as Simeon did recognize it at the Presentation of Jesus.

Scripture: "When the days were completed for their purification according to the law of Moses, they took him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, just as it is written in the law of the Lord, 'Every male that opens the womb shall be consecrated to the Lord,'" Luke 2:21-24

Mary: "The soft light of my Flame of Love will light up, spreading fire over the entire surface of the earth. Satan, humiliated and reduced to powerlessness, will not be able to exercise his power." (November 27, 1963)

Jesus: "I, who did everything for you in order to be 'the Light of the World' that you must follow; I, the Dispenser of strength to human weakness, I have convinced the world by showing, through My human nature also, the road that you must follow." (February 15, 1964)

5th Joyful Mystery – Jesus is found in the Temple

Fruit of the mystery: Devotion to Jesus



† Mary, who have welcomed in faith the mystery of the mission of your Son in the Temple, make us obedient to God's plan.

Scripture: "After three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions, and all who heard him were astounded at his understanding and his answers." Luke 2:41-47

Jesus: "Each night, my little one, ask yourself what you have done for the coming of my kingdom. Never be content with yourself. There is no room on earth for self-satisfaction. The reward of your labors is not a worldly reward. Work as hard as possible. See humiliation as a great instrument that guarantees abundant fruit for your work." (August 28, 1962)

Mary: "I can no longer hold back my Flame of Love in my heart. Let it leap out into all of you...." "Those accepting the Flame of Love will be intoxicated by the abundance of graces and they will proclaim everywhere, as I said before, that such a torrent of grace has never been granted since the Word became Flesh." (November 7, 1963)

The Luminous Mysteries

[Traditionally prayed on Thursdays]

1st Luminous Mystery – The Baptism in the Jordan

Fruit of the mystery: Openness to the Holy Spirit



† O Mary, who kept everything in your Heart, make us attentive to God's presence and grateful for the privileged grace of our baptism.

Scripture: "After Jesus was baptized, he came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove coming upon him. And a voice came from the heavens, saying, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.'" Matthew 3:16-17

Jesus: "Oh, with what love I suffered for all to obtain forgiveness for your sins from the heavenly Father. I beg you to help Me, so that many souls may recover this beautiful garment of grace which they received at Baptism." [His voice was imploring.] (March 23, 1963)

Mary: "The soft light of my Flame of Love will light up, spreading fire over the entire surface of the earth. Satan, humiliated and reduced to powerlessness, will not be able to exercise his power." (November 27, 1963)

2nd Luminous Mystery – The Wedding at Cana

Fruit of the mystery: To Jesus through Mary



† O Mary, Virgin of Cana, ask Jesus to change our hearts so that we may live ever more in the great freedom of God's children.

Scripture: "When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, 'They have no wine.' Jesus said to her, 'Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come.' His mother said to the servers, 'Do whatever he tells you.'" John 2:1-5

Jesus: "You are My little drop of water. Immerse yourself in the intoxicating wine of My infinite Divinity, both in its life-giving power and in its sweet aroma that you pour out for Me. May My good aroma pour out around you. When others perceive it, they will be led to Me. You see, we must be one." (May 17, 1963)

Mary: "Keep vigil over the silence of your soul, my little Carmelite. Give no entrance even to a whisper that might disturb the silence of your soul. Our words will continue to echo if you listen with humility and holy devotion." (October 9, 1963)

3rd Luminous Mystery – The Proclamation of the Kingdom

Fruit of the mystery: Conversion



† By your unceasing prayer, Mary, obtain for us to be authentic witnesses of the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Scripture: "'This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.'" Mark 1:15

Jesus: "I choose you, My little one, to be the bearer of My Divine Mercy. Fill yourself with the abundance of My Divine Mercy and when you open your mouth to speak, proclaim the mercy of My Heart burning of desire for sinners. Let your whole life be a burning desire to take part in My work of Redemption through prayer, sacrifice and desire." (May 4, 1962)

Mary: "You can only explain my Flame of Love to others by speaking about it. You have no right to be silent because of cowardice, pride, negligence or fear of sacrifice. Let the words you say about me be alive so the mystery of Heaven has an impact on souls." (July 26, 1971)

4th Luminous Mystery – The Transfiguration of Jesus

Fruit of the mystery: Desire for Holiness



† Mary, help us to be transformed by the Holy Spirit so we become your instruments of grace.

Scripture: "After six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. And he was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light." Matthew 17:1-2

Mary: "Sacrifice and prayer! These are your instruments. The goal is to bring about the powerful work of Salvation. Oh, if your desires reach the throne of the heavenly Father, the results will be abundant." (July 22-23, 1963)

Jesus: "Burn like the bush that burned but was not consumed. I need a similar sacrifice which is never consumed, and of which the flame burning from love touches Me." (August 1, 1963)

5th Luminous Mystery – The Institution of the Holy Eucharist

Fruit of the mystery: Adoration



† O Mary, Virgin of Contemplation, help us to increase our intimacy with Jesus in the Eucharist, the Bread of Life of every day.

Scripture: "While they were eating, Jesus took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and giving it to his disciples said, 'Take and eat; this is my body.'" Matthew 26:26

Mary: "The participation in the Holy Mass is what helps the most to blind Satan. Tormented and breathing out terrible vengeance, he wages a ferocious battle for souls since he feels the impending coming of his blindness." (November 22, 1962)

Jesus: "He who eats My Body and drinks My Blood remains in Me, and I in him. Immerse yourselves in My words. If God is in you, My little Elizabeth, how can you not also become divine?" (October 9, 1964)

The Sorrowful Mysteries

[Traditionally prayed on Tuesdays, Fridays, & during the season of Lent, on Sunday]

1st Sorrowful Mystery – The Agony in the Garden

Fruit of the mystery: Obedience to God's Will



† My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass Me by, nevertheless, let it be as You, not I, would have it." Mary, please take our sacrifices and console the heart of Jesus.

Scripture: "Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to his disciples, 'Sit here while I go over there and pray.' He took along Peter and the two sons of Zebedee and began to feel sorrow and distress. Then he said to them, 'My soul is sorrowful even to death. Remain here and keep watch with me.' He advanced a little and fell prostrate in prayer, saying, 'My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me; yet, not as I will, but as you will.'" Matthew 26:36-39

Mary: "I am the Mother of Sorrows, I suffer greatly because of the souls being lost. I am tortured in pain as I grieve for the suffering of my Divine Son. Never despise any tiredness, be my eternal companion helping me bear my sufferings. This is what I ask of you." (November 19, 1962)

Jesus: "In My agony, when I was sweating blood, the heavenly Father's consolation gave Me renewed strength to drink the cup of suffering to the bottom. It is as a Man that I suffered, refusing any help from My Divinity, so My Heart would feel as yours do." (December 15, 1963)

2nd Sorrowful Mystery – The Scourging at the Pillar

Fruit of the mystery: Mortification



† Mary, may our suffering, united to the scourging of Jesus, become a prayer of offering to the world.

Scripture: "Then he released Barabbas to them, but after he had Jesus scourged, he handed him over to be crucified." Matthew 27:26

Mary: "I, the Mother of Sorrows, feel as if, with each of your sufferings, you pour medicinal balm upon the wounds of my Divine Son." (May 4, 1962)

Jesus: "After receiving My Precious Blood, examine your souls and become aware of the exhilaration that the power of My Precious Blood brings about in you. Do not be so insensitive. Let not routine lead you to my holy table, but rather the fervor of sacrificial charity, which ignites through contact with My love. Through Me – inasmuch as you remain united to Me – it will burn sin out of your souls." (January 16, 1964)

3rd Sorrowful Mystery – The Crowning with Thorns

Fruit of the mystery: Courage



† May the thorns of our heart make the garden of our life blossom in faith with You, Mary.

Scripture: "Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus inside the praetorium and gathered the whole cohort around him. They stripped off his clothes and threw a scarlet military cloak about him. Weaving a crown out of thorns, they placed it on his head, and a reed in his right hand. And kneeling before him, they mocked him, saying,

"Hail, King of the Jews!" Matthew 27:27-29

Jesus: "With all the love of your heart, immerse yourself in My sorrowful Passion. When you arise in the morning, recall what was awaiting Me the entire day after the terrible torments of that night" (April 10, 1962)

Mary: "My little one, your acceptance of sacrifices and your faithfulness stir me to pour out upon all in a greater measure the effect of my Flame of Love." (November 6-7, 1962)

4th Sorrowful Mystery – Jesus Carries the Cross

Fruit of the mystery: Patience



† May our daily cross be made lighter by the sorrowful Cross of Jesus, which has become glorious by His Resurrection.

Scripture: "They pressed into service a passer-by, Simon, a Cyrenian, who was coming in from the country, the father of Alexander and Rufus, to carry his cross. They brought him to the place of Golgotha (which is translated Place of the Skull)." Mark 15:21-22

Jesus: While at work, contemplate the Way of the Cross and consider that I did not have any moment of rest. Totally exhausted, I was forced to climb the mount of Calvary. There is much to contemplate." (April 10, 1962)

Mary: The greater the number of souls who sacrifice and watch in prayer, the greater the power of my Flame of Love on earth will be... Because it is with the power of sacrifice and prayer that the flash of hellish hatred will be overcome." (December 6, 1964)

5th Sorrowful Mystery – The Crucifixion

Fruit of the mystery: Sorrow for our Sins



† May the final words uttered by Jesus on the Cross become seeds of life, love and forgiveness in all hearts.

Scripture: "There was a vessel filled with common wine. So they put a sponge soaked in wine on a sprig of hyssop and put it up to his mouth. When Jesus had taken the wine, he said, "It is finished." And bowing his head, he handed over the spirit." John 19:28-30

Mary: I am the Mother of Sorrows, I suffer greatly because of the souls being lost. I am tortured in pain as I grieve for the suffering of my Divine Son. Never despise any tiredness, be my eternal companion helping me bear my sufferings." (November 19, 1962)

Jesus: You, My little friend, with what joy I look at you. I thirst for every one of your words because these quench My yearning for souls. I have written My teaching and My thirst for souls deeply upon your soul. While I was hanging on the Cross, I cried out in a loud voice: 'I am thirsty.' I say these same words to all, especially to the souls consecrated to Me." (August 18, 1964)

The Glorious Mysteries

[Traditionally prayed on Wednesdays & outside the seasons of Advent and Lent, on Sundays]

1st Glorious Mystery, The Resurrection of Jesus

Fruit of the mystery: Faith



† Through the power of Your Resurrection, grant us Lord the taste of life, and reach out to those who have lost its meaning.

Scripture: "They found the stone rolled away from the tomb; but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. While they were puzzling over this, behold, two men in dazzling garments appeared to them. They were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground. They said to them, 'Why do you seek the living one among the dead? He is not here, but he has been

raised.'" Luke 24:1-5

Jesus: Desire to share in My work of Redemption! Let this be the supreme goal of your lives, the most valuable gift that you can bring to Me. Take advantage of every opportunity and every means to save souls. Work at it!" (January 15, 1964)

Mary: "When those persons consecrated to God and the faithful keep the Monday fast, they will free a multitude of souls from Purgatory each time they receive Communion during that week, at the very moment they receive the Holy Body of Our Lord Jesus Christ." (August 15, 1980)

2nd Glorious Mystery, The Ascension of Our Lord

Fruit of the mystery: Hope



† "Why are you standing here looking into the sky? Go out proclaim the Good News." May we become, O Lord, authentic witnesses of Your Resurrection.

Scripture: "So then the Lord Jesus, after he spoke to them, was taken up into heaven and took his seat at the right hand of God." Mark 16:19

Jesus: "Do not be attracted by the passing comfort of this world. The coming of My Kingdom must be your only purpose in life. (August 8, 1962)

Mary: "My little one, I extend the effect of grace of the Flame of Love of my heart over all the peoples and nations, not only over those living in the Holy Mother Church, but over all the souls marked with the sign of the blessed Cross of my Divine Son." — "Also over those who are not baptized." (September 16, 1963)

3rd Glorious Mystery, The Descent of the Holy Spirit

Fruit of the mystery: Wisdom



† Send forth Your Spirit, Lord, and give us the boldness of Your true disciples.

Scripture: "Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim." Acts 2:1-4

Jesus: "Have confidence and always refer to the Flame of Love of My Holy Mother because the Three Divine Persons are obligated to her. Through her, you can receive the graces you ask for. She is the Spouse of the Holy Spirit and her love warms up the hearts and souls which have grown cold in the world. Then, waking up with renewed energies, you will be able to rise towards God." (October 19, 1962)

Elizabeth: "Jesus spoke to me at length about the time of grace and the Spirit of Love quite comparable to the first Pentecost, flooding the earth with its power. That will be the great miracle drawing the attention of all humanity. All that is the effusion of the effect of grace of the Blessed Virgin's Flame of Love." (March 24, 1963)

4th Glorious Mystery, The Assumption of Mary into Heaven

5th Glorious Mystery, The Coronation of Mary in Heaven

Scripture: "A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars." - Revelation 12:1

Jesus: "On this day, venerate Our Mother in a special way with a very particular tenderness. As you are well aware, she is the Mother of all graces. Wish that she be venerated on earth as she is venerated in Heaven by the multitude of angels and saints." (April 10, 1962)

- Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, Our Lord, who was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried? **I do.**
- Do you believe that Jesus descended into hell; and on the third day rose from the dead, ascended into heaven and now sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty? **I do.**
- Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting? **I do.**

Close your eyes and imagine yourself clothed in a spotless, white garment, a symbol of your soul at Baptism and an image of a future life in heaven.

Now, envision an enormous Flame of Fire. You enter into the blaze. Do not be afraid. The Fire is Jesus, Himself, the Flame of Love. You are not alone, the Blessed Mother is with you. You are in the deepest part of her Heart, immersed in her Flame of Love. Our Lady fills you with great desires to accept more and more of this Flame. Surrender to the Flame and to having Jesus consume your whole life.

Now, accompany Jesus and Mary through the Mysteries of the Rosary. Through her Fiat, the Word is made Flesh in the Womb of the Blessed Mother. Upon Mary's greeting at the Visitation, Jesus sanctifies John the Baptist, who leaps for joy. Jesus is born in poverty and is laid in a manger where the Shepherds and the Wise Men gaze upon the Holy Face of God. At forty days, Jesus is revealed in the Temple as the Light for all nations and the glory of Israel. At twelve, He fills the same temple with His teachings.

At 30, Jesus is baptized. The heavens open and the Spirit of God descends like a dove on Him while the Father speaks, "This is my beloved Son." At Cana, He transforms water into wine. He preaches, heals, drives out demons and proclaims that the Kingdom of God is at hand. He reveals His Glory to Peter, James and John. On the night before His Passion, Jesus institutes the Holy Eucharist, with the words, "This is My Body, This is My Blood."

He goes to the Garden where He accepts the Father's will. He gives Himself over to men whom Satan uses as his instruments. He accepts the wounds on His back and the thorns upon His head. He accepts the cross, walks to Calvary and dies for you.

At His death, Jesus' soul departs his body and descends into hell to set free the souls of the just. On the Third day, He rises from the dead. Through His glorious Resurrection, Jesus triumphs over sin and death. He appears to His disciples, instructing them to make disciples of all nations, and ascends to the Father's Right Hand. Right now, the Blessed Mother wants to embrace you and pour out her Flame of Love in great abundance. This is a holy and sacred moment. Imagine the Flame leaping from her heart to yours and Mary giving you the Flame without limits. The Flame of Love is so great that she suffers until the Flame leaves her Heart and goes to yours, because it belongs in our hearts. She gives the Fire far beyond our capacity to receive. She wants to give us gifts that were meant for others but they did not receive. Receive this Flame for everyone — for yourself, your family, your friends.

Be still. The prayer is complete. Our Lady is pouring out the effects of grace of the Flame of Love. You may not realize all she has done for you this day because the effects sometimes unfold slowly and powerfully. Remain in silence and receive.
